NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANIZATION

- 1.1 The event is organized by Dobrzyński Klub Żeglarski together with the Polish Yachting Association, in conjunction with the International 29er Class Association
- 1.2 The regatta will be held in Dobrzyń nad Wisłą on the water of Zalew Włocławski from May $\mathbf{1}^{st}$ to $\mathbf{3}^{rd}$, 2009

2. RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 2.2 National authority prescriptions will not apply.
- 2.3 If there is any conflict between the Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.
- 2.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

3. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. Details will be provided in a separate notice.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the International 29er Class.
- 4.2 Each competitor shall be a current member of the International 29er Class Association.
- 4.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form available on the Web site www.kzdobrzyn.pl and sending it by e-mail to przybytek2@o2.pl or fax +48 54 253 10 34 before April 28th 2009
- 4.4 Parent/Guardian Declarations: All helms and crews under 18 years of age during the event shall submit signed Parent/Guardian Declarations either at above mentioned e-mail or fax or at the registration.

5. FEES

Entry fee is 100 EUR and must be paid at the registration in Dobrzyński Klub Żeglarski prior to the racing

6. EVENT FORMAT

For 50 or more entries, boats will be split into fleets, and qualifying and final series races will be held.

8. MEASUREMENTS

Boats can be inspected for class rules compliance during the regatta.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at the registration.

10. VENUE

Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbour and the racing area.

11. COURSES

The course to be sailed will be windward-leeward course.

12. PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 is changed so that Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by One-Turn Penalty.

13. SCORING

- 13.1 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 13.2 Series Scores
- (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When from 5 to 8 races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When 9 or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

14. SUPPORT BOATS

- 13.1 Support boats shall register at the Race Office during the registration period.
- 13.2 Support boats shall display their national letters on a flag or outboard covers.

15. PRIZES

- 15.1 There is a prize money fund of PLN 30.000,00 [approximately 7.000 EUR minus taxes] that will be divided according to the rules available at the registration.
- 15.2 Additionally there will be a free accommodation in the period from 30.04. until 03.05.2009 for one crew from each country who enter first to the regatta (first come first served)

16. RIGHTS TO USE NAMES & IMAGES

Competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or health sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.000.000 EUR per event or the equivalent.
